### 2 About FirstClass Server

FirstClass Server 12.1 SP1 Build 2156 is the next major release of the FirstClass core server.

#### 2.1 New Features

FirstClass Server 12.1 SP1 Build 2162 includes the following new features.

### 2.1.1 Configurable Directory Threads

- Added ability to change the number of directory threads at startup.
- [FCSetup] NumDirectoryThreads=4; // default 4.

#### 2.1.2 Configurable Encryption Threads

- Added ability to change the number of encryption threads at startup.
- [FCSetup]
- NumEncryption = 4; // default is 4.

### 2.1.3 Failed Login Attempts

- Added the ability to configure max failed login attempts on a per group basis.
- Default: 3 Min: 1 Max: 25

#### 2.1.4 Automatic Creation of Contacts

• Added new feature to create a contact for external recipients. This feature is enabled by default. It is configurable by individual users through their preferences.

#### 2.1.5 Video Chat

• Allow video chat between WebServices clients that support it.

### 2.2 Discontinued and Deprecated Features

• FirstClass Server index extensions for all platforms are deprecated.

### 5.2 Upgrade Notes



#### **Important**

Before you upgrade, review these instructions.

- Once you run the server version 12.1 and above you may not roll back to a previous version of the server.
- You must have a FirstClass 12.0 server license in order to login to this server as anything but the administrator account.
- Upon first start of the 12.1 server against an 12.0 network store a license validation process will occur which should take approximately the same length of time as doing a network store directory rebuild. No logins will be permitted until this process completes.
- Sites that have not enabled indexing will now run in 'file scan' mode.

  This is to allow permalinks and assigned tasks to function correctly in FCWS.

  When in this mode the file scan and parent audit parts of index catch up will run at startup, but no content will actually be indexed.
- This FirstClass 12.1 B2162 server release can be used as a FirstClass archive server. Due to the new 64-bit file class in FirstClass 12.1, a 12.0 archive server will not be able to archive messages larger than 2GB. For that reason, sites that use archiving should update their archive server to 12.1 SP1 before updating their core server to 12.1 SP1.

Administration	Fix to clean up DocAttr file when user deleted.			
Administration	Remove the external configuration form when the user account is deleted.			
Administration	Added HoldByPass to session calling HoldServerTasks, not just the button push, but allow fcputil to do this too.			
Administration	Fix for false positive DBTransID report when closing a monitor form.			
Administration	Fixed reporting crash when OCB is owned by the system and not another session.			
Administration	Added more reporting around DBTransID ownership.			
Administration	Added ability to change the number of encryption threads at startup. [FCSetup]  NumEncryption = 4; // default is 4.			
Administration	Added ability to change the number of directory threads at startup. [FCSetup] NumDirectoryThreads=4; // default 4.			
Archive Services	Treat ARCHIVEFOLDER subtypes as mailboxes when calculating settings.			
Archive Services	Fix to allow unlisted users and conferences items to be archived.			
Archive Services	Fix to not abort delivery because more than one chat participant is being archived.

Audit	Only avoid audit (during index load) when not a VLS site.			
Audit	Removed the potential for an Archive server to "manage" a user's mailbox.			
Batch Admin	Fixed the GET/PUT RESUME command to access the user's profile.			
Calendar	Send notification to the person assigning the task when it is accepted or declined.			
Calendar	A change made by the creator of an assigned task will reset the acceptance status of all involved.			
Calendar	Fix for incorrect parent records after seen when move task from mailbox to calendar.

Calendar	Fixed crash when updating users with task assignment and parent unknown.

Better reporting for group processing errors.				
Fixed a bug where indexing was not loaded but we still tried to add parents.				
Aborting recreating forward index now skips saving forward index at shutdown.				
Fix for index search returning items that are open by name.				
Report the index location in the log at startup.				
Sped up index scan by not waiting for current users data to be completely indexed, just down to a full open item queue size				
Fix crash when word has been removed from forward index.				
Fix relocating index outside the FCNS for OSX.				
The index location is now reported in the server console log.				
Changed the way files are removed from the index (from PhysDelete) so that they requests are queued and the MTA does not need to wait for them. Fixes server lockup seen at a small number of customer sites.				
Put indexv2 folder into the Mirror exclusion list.				
Aborting recreating forward index now skips saving forward index at shutdown.				
In File mode, indexer was not returning parent list.				
Fix for missing recipients when names are split over multiple packets.				
Fixed crash when a mail rule was being executed during the admin notification process at server start up.				
Fix for long subjects on message replies.				

Issue Name	Issue Description		
Shutdown	Log session that requested the Fast Shutdown. If no session logged, the server was shut down from the operating system.		
Statistics & Billing	Change to guarantee the file format is the first line the log file when initially created.		
Unread Tracking	Fix to send notifications to owners of personal containers that have been aliased to others.		
Versioning	Only apply versioning to containers that are being versioned.		

## 7 Known Issues

Issue Name	Issue Description
FCAS	FCAS build versions equal to or greater than 4098 up to but not including 4524 are not supported with this server build.  FCAS build versions prior to 3243 are not supported with this server build.
Archive Server	Due to the new 64-bit file class in FirstClass 12.1, a 12.0 archive server will not be able to archive messages larger than 2GB.
